Temperature How-To

Bell-Young Hall is a large building with many rooms. The temperature in the building is controlled by a central air conditioning system. The temperature in the building is set to 68°F (20°C) during the day and 75°F (24°C) at night.

If you are uncomfortable with the temperature in Bell-Young Hall, please contact the REHS staff at 302-338-1200. We can help you adjust the temperature in your room or provide you with a fan or other cooling device.

Temperature Tips

Need to cool down?

- Keep your room doors closed during the day. Open doors at night.
- Fans can help cool your room. Remember to use fans safely. Do not use fans near water or electrical outlets. Do not use fans in a room with a fire hazard.
- Check your room temperature regularly. If it is too hot, contact the REHS staff at 302-338-1200.
